## FAS Student Acrylic Paint Colours:

Lightfastness ratings indicate how resistant acrylic paint is to fading over time when exposed to light. Our Student Acrylic paint uses a star rating system to help you choose colours wisely:

### 1. \*\*\* (Maximum Lightfastness)

Blue Wool Scale: 7, 8

Description: These colours offer the highest resistance to fading, tested under museum conditions. They can last over 100 years without losing vibrancy, making them ideal for long-term display.

### 2. \*\* (High Lightfastness)

Blue Wool Scale: 5, 6

Description: These colours offer significant resistance to fading, suitable for artworks displayed in well-lit areas. With care, they can maintain their brilliance for extended periods.

### Understanding the Blue Wool Scale:

This scale ranges from 1 to 8, with higher numbers indicating greater resistance to fading.

### Making Informed Choices:

Choose colours based on your artwork's intended lifespan and the environment in which it will be displayed. Higher lightfastness ratings ensure your creations remain vibrant for years.
